

What is the POWER Program?

POWER offers forgivable loans to eligible Camden city homeowners to fund essential repairs to make homes safer and more energy efficient. Through the Program Offering Widespread Energy Recovery (POWER), the City of Camden hopes to achieve total energy savings (TES) of at least 25% in certain residential homes. The program is an expansion of the popular Camden Home Improvement Program (CHIP) focusing on energy efficiency retrofits. POWER is a City of Camden program, funded in part by the U.S. Department of Energy and the NJ Economic Development Authority managed by NJ Housing & Mortgage Finance Agency (NJHMFA) and Cooper's Ferry Partnership (CFP).

How do I apply for POWER?

If you think you are eligible, you should submit an application of interest.

You can pick up & submit applications at CFP's office at One Port Center. (Directions on back of brochure)

We encourage everyone interested to apply, even if you still have some unanswered questions. We will work closely with you during the interview process to have your questions answered.

What types of improvements does POWER cover?

Goal: The goal of the program is to achieve total energy savings (TES) of at least 25% in certain residential homes. A sample scope of services under POWER might include:

- Sealing existing air leaks
- Improving whole house insulation
- Replacing siding with external insulation
- Insulating boiler pipes and other spaces.

Health and Safety improvements: which ensure the ongoing safety of the occupants, such as fire safety, access, electrical, gas and plumbing. These might include:

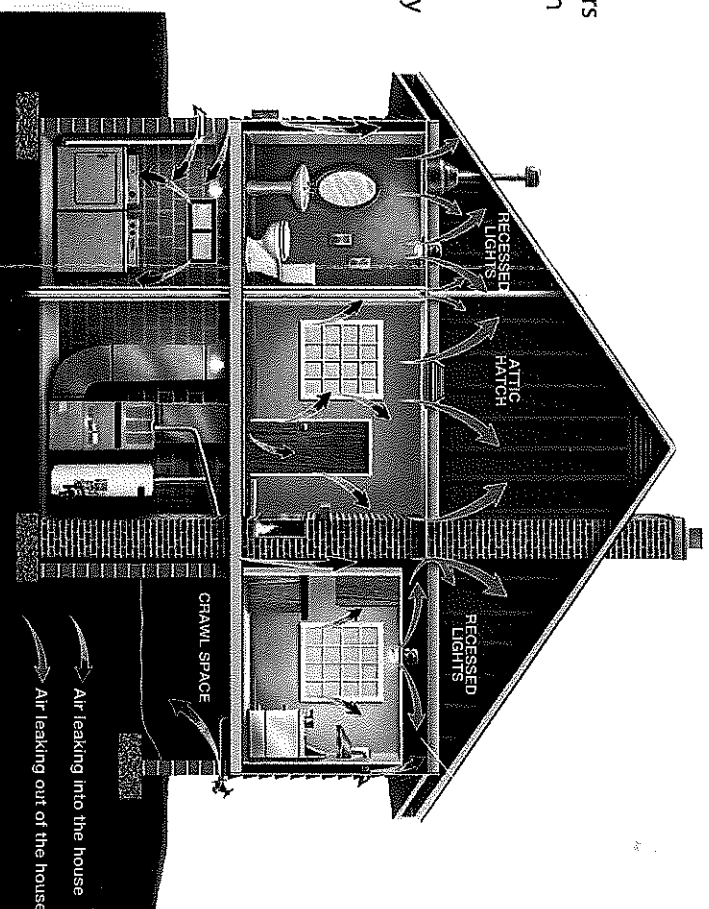
- Accessible exits
- Smoke Detectors
- Fix loose railings and stairs
- Gas appliance connection
- Clothes dryer venting
- Exhaust fan venting
- Fuel line leak repairs
- Improve indoor air quality



How does the program funding work?

POWER offers financing up to \$16,000 in the form of a state-program rebate and a 10 year forgivable loan for the eventual repair costs. As long as you own and live in your home for ten years after receiving this assistance, you won't need to repay any portion of the POWER Grant.

Who is eligible for POWER?

To qualify for POWER, eligible homeowners must satisfy all of the following conditions:

- Be 18 years old or over;
- Own and occupy the home as your primary residence for at least one (1) year;
- Plan to stay in your home for a minimum of ten years after receiving the loan;
- Be current on all municipal obligations including property taxes, water and sewer bills;
- Have no municipal or outside liens against the property;
- Be able to obtain 25% total energy savings (TES) after repairs;
- Have a household income that is below the incomes on the chart below;

POWER Income Limits*

To qualify for POWER, you must earn below the following income guidelines:

Household Size	Income Limit
1 person	\$43,560.00
2 people	\$58,840.00
3 people	\$74,120.00
4 people	\$89,400.00
5 people	\$104,680.00
6 people	\$119,960.00
7 people	\$135,240.00
8 people	\$150,520.00

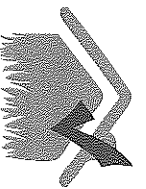
