

ORDINANCE NO. 1991-11

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN, COUNTY OF OCEAN, MODIFYING CHAPTER V OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN ENTITLED "GENERAL POLICE REGULATIONS" SPECIFICALLY SECTION 5-18 ENTITLED "RECYCLING".

BE IT ORDAINED by the TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE of the TOWNSHIP OF OCEAN, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 5-18 of Chapter V of the codified ordinances of the Township of Ocean, County of Ocean, entitled "Recycling" is hereby modified as follows.

Section 5-18.2 "Definitions" is modified to include the definition of "plastic containers" as follows:

Plastic containers shall mean bottles and other containers made of clear or colored plastic designed by the manufacturer thereof to hold drinkable liquid products for sale to the public, including but not limited to water, soda and/or milk products, as well as plastic containers and bottles made of HDPE and PVC components and chemical compounds.

PLASTIC CONTAINERS WHICH CONTAINED HAZARDOUS MATERIALS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING I.E. OIL, ANTIFREEZE, ETC.

Section 5-18.3 "Establishment of Program" is modified to include the following:

- h. Junk Mail and Magazines;
- i. White goods and scrap metal;
- j. Batteries - auto and marine;
- k. Batteries - household.

Section 5-18.4 is modified to include the following:

- c. White goods and scrap metal are not to be placed at the curb for pickup more than five calendar days prior to the designated pickup day. All other recyclables and solid wastes are not to be placed at the curb for pickup more than 24 hours prior to the designated pickup day.

Section 5-18.8 "Enforcement and Administration" is deleted in its entirety and in its stead is to be inserted the following:

The recycling coordinator is hereby authorized and directed to establish and promulgate reasonable regulations detailing the manner, days and times for the collection of the recyclable materials designated in sub-section 5-18.3 of this section and such other matters as are required to implement this section. Such regulations shall take effect only upon the approval of the Township Committee by adoption of a Resolution implementing the same. The recycling coordinator, code enforcement officer and/or members of the Ocean Township Police Department are hereby authorized and directed to enforce the provisions of this section and any implementing regulations adopted hereunder.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
