Trash Collection pick up for the entire town is Wednesdays

Recycling Collection for the entire town is Thursdays

### Leaf Pick Up Sections:

Section 1	Sands Point & Holiday Beach
Section 2	Barnegat Beach - Laurelwyck - Brookville Railroad Ave. & Route 9 North of Barnegat Beach
Section 3	Pebble Beach & Route 9 South of Barnegat Beach
Section 4	Skipper's Cove and Bay Haven

All cans, glass, plastic, paper and cardboard can be co-mingled in one can

### Single Stream Recycling

#### All Trash and Recycling Must Be Put Out The Night Before

"Recycle Stickers" can be obtained at Town Hall

Single Stream Recycling. Everything in one can. **Do Not Tie or Bundle.**  
All items must be rinsed clean – NO EXCEPTIONS.  
NO containers from hazardous materials.

No recyclable materials can be placed in plastic bags  
No more than three 32 gallon cans per household for garbage each week.  
Three (3) nonmetal furniture items can be placed at curb per pick up Couches are regular garbage unless a sleeper sofa, which you need to remove the metal bed part prior to pick up and call to be placed on the metal pick up for that item. The garbage company will not take a sleeper sofa with the metal still intact.

**Metal and Electronics Pick Up:** 2nd and 4th Thursday of each month.  
(Televisions, computers, laptops, monitors, DVD players, VCRs, fax machines and desktop printers)  
**You must call 609-693-3302 ext. 221 and schedule a pick up.**

**Branches:** 1st & 3rd Thursday of each month should be cut in 4 ft. sections  
**You must call 609-693-3302 ext. 221 and schedule a pick up.**

**CARPET:** can be picked up with regular garbage. Must be rolled, tied and no longer than 4 feet long. Each roll cannot weigh more than 75 pounds. No more than 3 rolls per pick up.

**Automobile and Marine Batteries:** are to be placed loose at curbside  
You **must** call 609-693-3302 ext. 221 and schedule a pick up.

Payment stickers are **required** for refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners.  
There is a charge of \$10.00 to certify that the item is freon free.

Propane Tanks are charged \$5.00

**ALL** items shall not be placed curbside for no more than 2 days prior to pick up.

Motor oil and tires are to be brought to Ocean County Southern Recycling Center on 379 Haywood Road, Manahawkin.

## ACCEPTABLE PLASTIC

- Plastic buckets with metal handles
- Plastic Milk/soda crates
- Plastic laundry baskets
- Plastic lawn furniture
- Plastic landscape & microwave trays
- Plastic totes - any size (with metal)
- Plastic dish drainers
- Plastic toys & playhouses
- Plastic car seats
- Plastic pet carriers
- Plastic pallets
- Plastic closet organizers
- Plastic traffic signs
- Empty garbage cans (any size)
- PET blister pack
- 5 gallon water bottles
- Computer housing (no circuits)
- Automotive plastics
  - > Bumpers
  - > Bed liners (pick up trucks)
  - > Grills
  - > Side-view mirror housing (no glass)
  - > Head lights & Rear light covers (no glass)
  - > Hub-caps, etc
- Plastic shelving

## NON-ACCEPTABLE PLASTIC

- PVC Pipe/tubing, Vinyl Siding
- Plastic film (Grocery bags & Stretch film)
- Styrofoam of any kind
- Coolers
- Poly-coated Paper (Orange juice & milk cartons)
- Flexible Water Hoses
- Hazardous material
- Medical waste
- Plastic flower pots
- Narrow-neck liquid containers - Used small-mouth containers
  - > Small plastic containers (Yogurt cups, PET/HDPE Bottles, etc.)
  - > Oil/Chemical containers (HDPE)
- Plastic drums (any size)

**DO NOT** place at the curb  
with your single stream recyclables.

**Paint**– latex, oil based and boat paints ONLY. **NO stains or wood preservative, no aerosol cans. Gasoline cans, turpentine and kerosene cannot be taken.**

Recycling -cardboard, newspaper, magazines, glass, cans, bottles, plastic containers

**NO CONTRACTOR OR CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS**

**TIRES** – Limited to **(8) per household**, **MUST** be taken OFF the rims,  
**NO Commercial ONLY** Passenger Tires

Proof of Residency is needed.

There will be people to assist residents with placing items in the correct dumpsters.
