The simple answer is no. Your request to collect documents and then have them shred does not fit the model of the program. A Problem encountered at every event is the individual concern for the security of the documents. We honestly have people bring documents which have already been shredded to be shredded again. It would be shocking if anyone would give their confidential documents to anyone to be taken to a site for storage and then shredding. Over the last few years we have worked very hard to establish a schedule that would benefit all County residents, Watchung has been part of this endeavor and while a host site may not be available locally you absolutely have the opportunity to participate by assisting another host community. Currently when we have a shred day in Hillsborough, Manville and Branchburg provide manpower to assist. The same can be said of Bedminster with Bernardsville and Peapack/Gladstone. I would ask that your efforts be directed towards working with Green Brook and Warren to come up with a plan that could benefit all of your municipalities.
