RESOLUTION

R6: 11/10/10

RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE ADOPTION OF GREEN BUILDING PRACTICES FOR CIVIC, COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS

WHEREAS, buildings account for 39% of CO2 emissions - more than either the transportation or industrial sectors. In addition, buildings account for nearly 12% of potable water use, 62% of waste output, and 73% of electricity consumption in the U.S. (Green Building Council); and

WHEREAS, green building - also referred to as sustainable or high-performance building - is a collection of better design, construction, and operating practices that have the potential to reduce or eliminate the negative impacts of development on the environment and on human health. There are many examples of green building programs and guidelines that have been promulgated at national, state, and municipal levels. They consistently address energy efficiency and carbon emissions reduction, water conservation, productivity and health, and other components of green building and sustainable development; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this resolution is to enhance the public welfare and assure that commercial, residential and civic development is consistent with the Governing Body of the Borough of Watchung's desire to create a more sustainable community by incorporating green building measures into the design, construction, operation and maintenance of buildings; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Watchung desires to set a leadership example in the area of green building through the implementation of energy efficiency audits and upgrades to the municipal building stock, continued procurement and other conservation practices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Watchung hereby implements a Green Building Policy that will consider opportunities to incorporate green building measures into the design, construction, operation and maintenance of municipal buildings and facilities.

SOMERSET COUNTY ANNOUNCES YEAR-ROUND MEDICINE DROP-OFF SITE

Collection program addresses growing problem of prescription drug abuse & concerns about improperly discarded medicines harming the environment

SOMERVILLE - Somerset County has begun a free medicine-collection program for residents to safely dispose of unwanted, expired or unused medicines. This is the first year-round medicine collection offered in the Somerset County area.

The drop-off site set up by the New Jersey Division of Consumer Affairs, in cooperation with the Somerset County Sheriff's Office and the Somerset County Board of Freeholders, accepts prescription and over-the-counter drugs, as well as pet medicines.

Medicines from households are accepted Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., at the entrance of the Sheriff's Office, located at the lower level of the county administration building. To search for directions online or via GPS device, use this address: Somerset County Administration Building, 20 Grove St., Somerville, NJ 08876.

For drop-offs after hours and on holidays and weekends, residents are asked to go to the secured front entrance of the Somerset County Administration Building on Grove Street, dial 908-526-2500 on their cell phone, and request a Sheriff's cadet escort. A Sheriff's cadet will greet them at the door and escort them to the medication drop box.

"The drop-off program is a free, anonymous, no-questions-asked initiative that prevents pill abuse and theft by ridding homes of potentially dangerous expired, unused and unwanted prescription drugs," said Sheriff Frank Provenzano. "Medicines that languish in home cabinets are highly susceptible to diversion, misuse and abuse."



If you are creating your test message from a remote telephone, remember to use your security code to gain access the unit and to use the call termination command.
