

TOWNSHIP COM. MTG. DATE: JUNE 25, 1990

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING  
CHAPTER II (ADMINISTRATION-ENVIRONMENTAL  
COMMISSION) OF THE "REVISED GENERAL  
ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HOWELL"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the Township Committee  
of the Township of Howell, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey  
as follows:

Section 1. Findings. The Township Committee of the  
Township of Howell hereby determines to clarify the prerogatives  
of the Howell Township Environmental Commission.

Section 2. Amendments. Pursuant to L. 1972, c.35, all  
references in the "Revised General Ordinances of the Township of  
Howell" to a Conservation Commission are hereby amended to read  
Environmental Commission.

Section 3. Amendment. Article 13.11 of Chapter 2 of the  
"Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Howell" is hereby  
amended to read

2-13.11 Appointment of Clerks and Office Employees.  
The commission may appoint a secretary, clerks and  
other employees, including, but not limited to,  
custodians or supervisors of lands, professionals  
and consultants, as it may from time to time require  
and as shall be within the limits of any funds  
appropriated to it.

Section 4. Amendment. Article 13 of Chapter 2 of the  
"Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Howell" is hereby  
amended and supplemented to include an Article 13.12 as follows;

2-13.12 Review of Environmental Impact Reports  
All reasonable costs incurred by the Commission in  
reviewing environmental impact reports referred to  
it by the township planning board pursuant to  
township ordinance 14-5c shall be paid for by the

applicant seeking approval before the planning board from amounts deposited with the township to cover the cost of reviewing such application.

Section 5. Severability. If any section or subsection of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other sections or subsections or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid section or subsection, to the extent such section or subsection is severable.

Section 6. Inconsistency. All ordinances and sections or subsections of ordinances which are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 7. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication according to law.
