

Brownfields Inventory and Prioritization: Policy for Updating List Trenton, NJ

Trenton's Brownfields Program currently updates their Brownfields Action Plan, last updated in June 2014 (http://www.trentonnj.org/Documents/BEST_Action_Plan_6-20-14.pdf), every four years. At minimum, the City's Brownfields Coordinator will update the Brownfields Inventory for Sustainable Jersey concurrent with the Brownfields Action Plan. The Brownfields Inventory for Sustainable Jersey was last updated in May 2015.

The Brownfields Coordinator, responsible for management of the City's Brownfields Program, is a full-time professional position within the City of Trenton's Department of Housing & Economic Development. The proposed timeframe is well within the 6.5 year time limit established by Sustainable Jersey for the utility of Brownfields Inventories and priority lists.

The priority list is likely to be updated more frequently as sites are remediated and redeveloped and, therefore, reprioritized or removed from the list.
