## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR DESIGNATION OF THE PROPOSED ASSUNPINK CREEK GREENWAY AS A BROWNFIELDS DEVELOPMENT AREA

**WHEREAS**, the City of Trenton has the opportunity to apply to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) for designation of the proposed Assunpink Greenway as a Brownfield Development Area; and

**WHEREAS**, this designation would provide increased technical support from the NJDEP and potentially provide priority status in obtaining additional grant funds for the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Assunpink Creek Greenway Steering Committee was established in 1999 to provide input in the process of establishing the greenway and will continue to partner with the City in this endeavour.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Trenton that the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit an application to the NJDEP for designation of the Assunpink Creek Greenway as a Brownfield Development Area, accept the designation, and execute any and all documents necessary in connection with the designation, including a Memorandum of Understanding with DEP and the Assunpink Creek Greenway Steering Committee.



**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF TRENTON TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND THE BETTER ENVIRONMENTAL SOLUTIONS FOR TRENTON COMMITTEE FOR THE MAGIC MARKER BROWNFIELDS DEVELOPMENT AREA**

**WHEREAS**, in 2003, the Magic Marker site, and other contiguous brownfield sites, were designated as one of the first "Pilot" Brownfields Development Areas (BDA) in the State of New Jersey by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP); and

**WHEREAS**, since that time the BDA designation has allowed the City of Trenton to receive significant grant funds and technical assistance for Brownfields sites within BDA; and

**WHEREAS**, additional funding and technical assistance may be received from the State of New Jersey on a priority basis through continuing the BDA designation; and

**WHEREAS**, the NJDEP is now requiring that the City of Trenton and the Better Environmental Solutions for Trenton (BEST) Committee (the designated steering committee for the BDA) execute a Memorandum of Understanding with NJDEP in order to receive additional financial and technical assistance under the BDA Program; and




