

Fleet Inventory Statement

Since 2011 we have continued to reduce the size of our Fleet. We intend to continue replacing our low MPG light duty vehicles with higher MPG units and downgrading vehicle size where appropriate. Our goal is to continue reducing our Fleet as the opportunities arise and replace with an appropriate high MPG Vehicle when a replacement is in order.

In the 2014-2015 time period we replaced 5 of our light duty vehicles that had a MPG rating between 12-18 City / 17-21 Highway with Vehicles that have a MPG ratings between 16-22 City and 26-30 Highway, thus meeting the challenge of reducing light duty fuel consumption by 20 percent, by doing so we are continuing to ensure a more efficient fleet. We have also replaced 4 of our older model Mason Dump that were retro fitted with the BART System with 2015-2016 Certified Clean Idle Diesels, thus reducing the impact of carbon emissions.

The Township Fleet Inventory of 5/5/2016 is now comprised of 26 Police Vehicle, 12 Tandem/Single Axle Trucks, 2 Sweepers, 23 Pick Ups/Mason Dumps, 11 SUV's, 2 Vans, 3 Transits, 12 Passenger Vehicles and 1 Seniors Transport Bus.

We continue to be aggressive with vehicle maintenance to ensure equipment in running at peak efficiency and require driver inspection for all vehicles to insure safe and properly running vehicles.
