

Woodbridge Solar Challenge FAQ

Who is Woodbridge Township working with to launch the Solar Challenge program?

- Woodbridge Township is working with Sustainable Jersey a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, who partners with EnergySage to encourage the adoption of solar energy.
 - Sustainable Jersey is a 501(c) (3) nonprofit organization, which supports N.J. community efforts to reduce waste, cut greenhouse gas emissions, and improve environmental equity.
 - EnergySage is an online solar marketplace developed with the support of the U.S.
 Department of Energy.

What is the Woodbridge Solar Challenge?

- The Woodbridge Solar Challenge is a community-led program that is working in partnership with the EnergySage online marketplace making buying solar transparent and simple.
 - What makes it a "Challenge" is that Woodbridge is competing against six other municipalities to achieve the highest number of new solar installations!
 - The duration of the program is from October, 2016 through May, 2017.

What makes this program unique?

- This program seeks to reduce the confusion of buying solar, and it allows residents to comparison shop for solar online.
 - The uniqueness of this program is that residents connect to the EnergySage marketplace to shop for solar, instead of being shopped by installers.
 - This program reduces confusion for the buyer, and streamlines the number of potential clients for reliable local installers.

What makes the online EnergySage process easy and reliable?

- The site was developed with the support of the U.S. Department of Energy, and when
 residents shop on the site they can expect a match making type of process that has been
 described as the Trivago or Priceline for solar.
 - It's a simple three step process: Step one: register online and complete your property profile, Step 2: <u>pre-screened installers</u> submit quotes online, Step 3: compare quotes online and pick the best one to start saving with solar.
 - The EnergySage installer screening process notes that solar companies listed on the site must have at least 3 years of experience installing solar PV; be licensed and insured for solar PV; NABCEP certified; have a reputation for excellent customer service and quality solar installations; and use high quality solar equipment.

What are the Township's goals for launching this program?

- The program seeks to increase the number of solar installations in the community in order to enhance Woodbridge Township's sustainability, and to help invigorate local solar businesses.
 - Combating climate change while making it easier and more transparent for members of the community to get solar power.
 - Promote local green industry.
