Dear Sustainable New Jersey,

Concord Energy Services (CES), an Energy Agent, Private Aggregator and Energy Consultant duly registered with the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities, administered the electric power supply procurement processes for the Hunterdon County Cooperative Pricing System ("HCCPS"), including most recently a Request for Bids (RFB) issued on July 30, 2019 for which bids were accepted from and contracts were awarded to electric power suppliers on August 20, 2019, for service from October 2019 through September 2021.

CES hereby certifies that the July 2019 RFB specifications included a section entitled voluntary opt-in option renewable energy product that consists of a total amount of renewable energy that is 20% greater than the total amount of renewable energy (Class I, Class II and solar combined) required by virtue of the New Jersey Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) in any given RPS compliance year (otherwise referred to as Energy Year or 'EY'<sup>1</sup>), with the additional 20% above and beyond the RPS requirements to be comprised of New Jersey RPS-compliant Class I renewable energy; that is, Class I renewable energy generated within or delivered into the PJM region, consistent with N.J.A.C. 14:8-2.7 (otherwise referred to as 'PJM Class I RECs').

Kingwood Township is a member of the HCCPS whose facilities were included in the RFB and whose electric accounts are currently being provided power supply by MidAmerican Energy Services under a contract awarded by the HCCPS in October 2019 and has affirmatively opted in to receive the voluntary renewable energy product. A copy of the additional voluntary renewable energy opt in form is attached for your review.

This statement of certification is being provided in support of the Kingwood Township application to Sustainable Jersey for the *Buy Electricity From A Renewable Source* action under the Sustainable Jersey certification category Energy Projects.

My Municipality chooses to OPT-IN to the Voluntary Enhanced Renewable Energy Option in Bid Group 1A at the contract rate of \$0.08103/kWh for our JCP&L General Service Electricity Accounts. The Voluntary Enhanced Renewable Energy Option consists of renewable energy that is 20% greater than the total amount of renewable energy (Class I, Class II and solar combined) required by virtue of the New Jersey Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS) in any given RPS compliance year. By electing to opt-in to the additional 20% renewable, up to 48% of the generation will be covered by generation certificates from renewable sources, such as wind, solar and bio-mass at a minimally higher cost, but still with savings to the Municipality.


