## Initial Wildflower Meadow Planting – Spring 2017 – Phase 1

- Bordered by Park Ave and MRC trail
- @ 200 ft. from trail head to Bradford Pear trees
- Annual & perennial seed mix (native and naturalized)
- 400+ 2" native perennial plugs
- Funded by Open Space Trust Fund (\$1,500), Garden Club of Madison (\$400), New Jersey Beekeepers Association (\$200)
- Site prep by volunteers and rental equip.

## Proposed Wildflower Meadow Expansion – Fall 2018 – Phase 2

- Bordered by Park Ave and MRC trail
- @ 280 ft. between Bradford Pear tree stands (site currently grass)
- Native perennial pollinator seed mix (16 forbs – spring to fall bloom)
- Proposed funding source; Open Space Trust Fund (\$800)
- Site prep (mow and till) by DPW
